\* Learn-to-Compete is open to all skaters from Snowplow 2 through Basic 6. Skaters will learn the skills needed for local competitions, plus other fun group skills. Skaters will have the option to sign up to compete in area competitions.

\*ASPIRE Academy is a fun class with an individualized approach for skaters who have passed Basic 6 who wish to further pursue figure skating. ASPIRE skaters will also have the option to purchase an introductory US Figure Skating club membership with the Brooklyn Figure Skating Club.
